Box 9775, Mississippi State, MS 39762-9775). Reports will be included in *Birds Around the State* and possibly *North American Birds*. Distinguishing features seen should be noted for species that are easily misidentified. *Records are accepted anytime, but to ensure consideration for season reports in North American Birds, winter reports (December-February) should be received by 20 March, spring reports (March-May) by 20 June, summer reports (June-July) by 20 August, and fall reports (August-November) by 20 December.*
